Alexander Batalov is an associate professor at the Faculty of law of M.V. Lomonosov Moscow State University. He has been lecturing and doing research on public international law and international air law since 2002. Moreover, Alexander also regularly provides expert advice on various issues of international air law at request of the Russian Government and governmental authorities and participates as a member of the governmental delegations at different international meetings, such as sixth ICAO Worldwide Air Transport Conference held in Montreal.

Alexander Batalov also practices law as a Counsel at Moscow office of CMS International, which is one of the international law firms with wide European network. For over a decade he has been providing legal advice to Russian and foreign entities operating in Russia on various legal issues, including general commercial law and aviation law.

Alexander Batalov graduated with honors from the Faculty of law of M.V. Lomonosov Moscow State University in 1999 and also obtained an LL.M. (Master of Laws) degree in International Air and Space Law from Leiden University in 2001. In 2004 Alexander successfully defended his Ph.D. thesis devoted to problems of international air law at Moscow State University.
